This six-day program, a collaboration among Michael Vincent Miller, Ruella Frank and Jean-Marie Robine, three international trainers and theorists, is intended for experienced practitioners as well as trainers of Gestalt therapy. The emphasis is on expanding possibilities and exploring new horizons in our work. Foundational concepts of Gestalt therapy, such as contacting, contact-boundary, theory of self, etc., will be scrutinized and given new shape. Some of our concerns to be taken up: The phenomenology of movement in early development and therapy; anxiety, depression, and trauma from a temporal point of view; the central place of form in the aesthetics of health and pathology; reflexivity--the moving I and the feeling Me--in the theory of self.

Each half-day, one of the presenters will open the topic and the other two join in to contribute to a further illumination of the theme, and arrive at an integration of our various perspectives. There also will be ample time for experiments, small group discussion, and therapy demonstrations to ground this new material in participants' experience.

Trainers

Michael Vincent MILLER (New York, United States) has practiced and taught Gestalt therapy for forty years, currently in New York City. His own training was chiefly with Fritz Perls, the Polsters, and for many years with Isadore From. After ten years of teaching at Stanford University and M.I.T., he co-founded the Boston Gestalt Institute, where he directed training. He has also trained psychotherapists in Gestalt therapy in a dozen countries. He was on the editorial board of the *Gestalt Journal* and was Consulting Editor to the *International Gestalt Journal*. Besides contributing numerous articles to many journals and magazines, he reviewed books on psychology and related areas for the *New York Times Book Review* from 1985 to 1994. He is the author of four books: *Intimate Terrorism: The Crisis of love in an Age of Disillusion* (Norton, 1996), which has been published in eight languages; *La Poétique de la Gestalt-thérapie* (Exprimerie, 2002); *Teaching a Paranoid to Flirt* (Gestalt Journal Press, 2011), a collection of his writings over thirty years on Gestalt therapy; and *A Gestalt Therapy Testament* (Casaperlarte, Milan, 2014), published in English and Italian.

Ruella FRANK (New York, United States), Ph.D., is founder and director of the Center for Somatic Studies, and faculty at Gestalt Associates for Psychotherapy and the New York Institute for Gestalt Therapy. Ruella, a student of Laura Perls, teaches workshops throughout the United States, Canada, Mexico and various European countries. She authored the book *Body of Awareness: A Somatic and Developmental Approach to Psychotherapy*, (2001, GestaltPress, available in 4 languages) and co-authored *The First Year and the Rest of Your Life: Movement, Development and Psychotherapeutic Change* (2010, Routledge Press, available in 3 languages). Her training video *Introduction to Developmental Somatic Psychotherapy*, now subtitled in French and Russian, is available at www.somaticstudies.com

Jean-Marie ROBINE (Bordeaux, France), Psy. Dipl., is a clinical psychologist since 1967, Gestalt-therapist since 1977 and international trainer in 35 countries. Past director of Institut Français de Gestalt-thérapie (1980-2007), co-founder and past-president of European Association for Gestalt Therapy, full member of Collège Européen de Gestalt-thérapie, full member of New York Institute for Gestalt Therapy, co-founder and past-editor of 2 French Gestalt Journals, author of many articles and of 8 books about Gestalt Therapy. His books *On the Occasion of an Other* (Gestalt Journal Press) and *Social Change Begins with Two* (Istituto di Gestalt HCC Press) have been translated into 7 languages. He edited recently *Self, a Polyphony of Contemporary Gestalt Therapists* (www.exprimerie.fr) with 20 major theoreticians, available in French, English, Spanish, Russian, soon in Italian and Portuguese.
